Ten Techniques for Brainstorming

1. Familiarize Yourself with The Text

Before you start with your essay, familiarize yourself with the text. You need to sit and think calmly so that you can get all the relevant points needed to be mentioned in your essay. Your readers should not need to guess about your position; it is one of the ways to achieve your purpose.

8. Repeat your central theme

During brainstorming make sure that you have enough space to repeat your central theme in your essay. Sometimes listeners may forget your purpose – you can avoid it with the repetition of your central idea. You can rephrase it, add relevant stories, metaphors, and literary devices so that readers can comprehend your point of view.

9. Definition

A good essay mainly tells and justifies the position of the writer. Its main point is to enforce one's objective over another person and why his position is important to adopt. The issue addressed in an essay could be related to society, individual well-being, or change in an academic path.
