Brainstorming

Brainstorming involves writing everything that comes to your mind about the topic without worrying about mechanics or grammar. Brainstorming helps to generate ideas about a topic and it is highly helpful in essay writing. Start by writing everything you know about the topic at hand in a relaxed informal manner. Write words, fragments, and sentences that you think are related to the essay. Also, write important vocabulary items that are needed to explain the topic.

Outlining

Outlining is an important step in writing an essay because it helps in the organization, saves time, and minimizes errors. Outlines give a logical flow to your essay, so it is highly important that you make a detailed outline before writing your essay. From the data you have accumulated about the topic by brainstorming, make an outline with an introduction, body paragraphs, and conclusion. Writing a Focused Thesis Statement

The thesis statement should be focused and act as a concise summary of your whole essay. The topic sentence should contain your topic statement and your claim, analysis, stance, or controlling idea. The thesis statement should clearly state the main topic of the essay and your assertions about it.

Remember that the thesis statement is always placed at the end of the introductory paragraph.

How to Write the Body Paragraphs

In five-paragraph essays, the body part of the essay typically comprises three paragraphs. You can add as many paragraphs to the body according to the needs of your particular essay. Each body paragraph should contain a clear single idea which is stated in the first lines of the body paragraph in the form of a topic sentence. The body paragraphs should explain, analyze, and exemplify that topic sentence and should not contain things that are not relevant to the topic sentence. The supporting evidence should be written in a logical and comprehensible manner. Use transition sentences at the end of each body paragraph to lead to the next idea.

Using Transitions

To spice up your writing, add transition sentences whenever possible. Transition sentences help increase the coherence and cohesion of the essay by creating logical relations between sentences and ideas. For example, the transition 'however' is used to present an opposing stance, the word 'furthermore' is used before explaining additional evidence, and the word 'for instance' is used to exemplify something.

Without transition sentences and words, your essay will be monotonous at best and illogical at worst.

Citing Sources

Your teacher will expect you to cite the sources that you have used to support your claims or assertions. When you consult outside courses such as books, journals, or newspaper articles, you are expected to

cite them because they are not your own ideas. You can cite sources by writing the last name of the author followed by the year of publication of the material and place them in rounded brackets. At the end of the paper, list all your sources under the heading references. Some popular forms of citation styles include MLA, APA, Chicago, and Harvard.

Writing the Conclusion

The conclusion should be of moderate length and restate your thesis statement. Apart from a restatement of your thesis statement, the conclusion paragraph should also contain a brief summary of your main assertions and a summation of your whole essay. Also, remember to reiterate the topic sentences one by one in the order that they appeared in the body paragraph. End the essay with concluding thoughts, calling to action, or referring back to the introduction of the essay.

Revising, Proofreading, and Editing

Let's be realistic here. No writer, no matter how much literary acumen he or she possesses, is not able to write a top-quality essay on the first try. You have to polish your essay by revising, proofreading, and editing it. After you are done with your first draft, revise it and highlight errors, weak assertions, and vague sentences. Proofread again to find grammatical and functional errors. When you are done with revising and proofreading, edit the essay and rewrite parts you are not satisfied with. Repeat this process until your essay starts to look professional and immaculate.
